We, the Italian helpers and the International Pathwork Foundation, invite you to come to Italy for the next International Pathwork Conference—to come together as a community to anchor in the experience of Oneness.

As Pathworkers, we are dedicated to our personal transformation work. We give much time and effort to self-exploration, self-confrontation, self-purification. We are familiar with the subtleties of our psychological processes. But most of us long to explore ourselves and reality beyond what is merely personal and relates only to the individual self. We long to taste life nourished by the experience and realization of who we truly are, not separate from the totality of existence—one with all that is.

Our desire is to focus on this deep inner longing and to fuel it. We will also have an opportunity to become more familiar with what waits for us on the evolutionary journey the Guide has mapped for us.

We propose to pool the experience and resources of individuals and regions from all over the world to explore "The Great Transition". We will place into the center of our attention how we access the Divine Self from our separated state, how we anchor our sense of self in the Greater Consciousness, and how we meet the fears that keep us from surrendering to our true identity.

How do we awaken within the Pathwork process? Who are we when the "old cloak" falls off?

The invitation for the two days of September 15 and 16 is for Pathwork helpers. We envision creating space for the essence of the teachings on Awakening and Oneness. Working with the Guide's practices and sharing our own knowing and experience of these themes, we will evolve our understanding and realizations towards becoming

more aligned and committed instruments of Divine Will and Love. This call is for us to come together beyond our roles and functions to give expression to the mission of our souls.

The general conference September 17 to 21 is open to Pathworkers with at least three years of Pathwork Studies or a recommendation by a helper. We will come together in various formats: in the large circle, in groups of different sizes, and in small home base groups. Presentations and workshops on a spectrum of themes will be offered. All will serve the central theme, the Guide's promise of guiding us to the truth of our Oneness with Source. In sharing and process, and through teachings, meditations and movement, we will be invited to give voice to our longing; to explore how to access our True Self; to face and accept our resistances; and to discover how to anchor and stabilize in that state of being. There will be ample time for connecting and playing, sunbathing, swimming, canoeing and sharing the pleasure of Italian food.

We will meet in the beautiful secluded vacation village of Cala d'Arconte, a beach resort two hours south of Naples (the location also of the 2002 International Pathwork Conference). We hope that all those who feel touched by our words will join us here on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea, in a country that values, above all the joys of communicating and togetherness.
